



## Call for Applications

### **Tenure-track position in Marine Science**

The Interuniversity Institute for Marine Sciences in Eilat (IUI), Israel, is inviting applications for a tenure-track faculty position. Areas of interest include (but are not limited to) biological, chemical and physical oceanography, coral-reef biology, marine microbiology and ecology, with strong orientation for field research. Candidates are expected to carry out research that benefits significantly from the unique location of the IUI on the shore of the Red Sea, next to a flourishing coral reef and in close proximity (minutes of cruising) from deep oligotrophic waters. Faculty positions at the IUI are jointly appointed by the IUI and a “home university”- one of the 7 research universities in Israel. Accordingly, the nomination procedure will consist of two stages; first at the IUI and then, if successful, at the home university of the candidate’s choice.

Appointments are expected to be at the Lecturer or Senior Lecturer (Assistant Professor) level. The successful candidate is expected to develop and sustain an outstanding research program and contribute to the teaching program at the IUI and his/her home university. Anticipated start date is October 1st, 2017.

Applications should include curriculum vitae (including list of publications), statement of research and teaching interests, pdf copies of 2 representative publications, and two letters of recommendation which should be sent directly to the address below.
