<u>Summary of Information Regarding the Absorption of New Resident Students</u> for the Academic Year 2025-2026

Dear Researchers,

1. The process of absorbing new resident students:

- 1) A researcher from an Institute of Higher Education in Israel who is interested in their student carrying out research at the Institute with the status of a *resident student* should fill out and submit an application form.
- 2) A notice of acceptance will be given by the Institute's Secretariat who will also contact the students for coordination and assessments for admission to the Institute.
- 3) <u>Prerequisites for students with permanent resident status at the Institute:</u>
 - 1. Approval of studies for the academic year 2025-2026 official approval from the Student Accounts Unit or the Student Registry at the university where the student is enrolled in a master's or doctoral program in the academic year 2025-2026 *.
 - 2. Conducting active and ongoing research in the field of the sea in one of the Institute's laboratories in Eilat.
 - 3. Permanent residence in Eilat or in one of the localities in the Eilat area.
 - 4. Activity in the Institute of at least 75% of the weekly working time (= 30 hours per week).
 - 5. Participation in 70% of the Institute's seminars.
 - 6. Publication of the name of the Institute on each article and academic work as a second affiliation (in addition to the parent university).
 - 7. The name of the Institute must be cited in any publication in the general press or in any communication to the media related to the student's work.
 - *As much as you have, otherwise documents must be completed by the beginning of the academic year.

<u>For the avoidance of doubt</u>: Responsibility for managing the research work and the student's well-being lies with the researcher and not with the Institute.

2. Teaching positions for new resident students:

- 1. Students who will be in their first year at the Institute will be able to apply for teaching positions. A call will be sent via email by the Teaching Coordinator, Dr. Bracha Farstey.
- 2. Please note, applications for Teaching Assistant positions to be received by 15.7.25.
- 3. The decision regarding acceptance of the position is subject to the Teaching Committee.

 Note: Students can apply for Teaching Assistant positions before receiving an answer about their admission at the Institute.

3. Scholarships for new resident students

- 1) Responsibility for the support of graduate students and their well-being lies with the supervisors and the parent university.
- 2) However, this year the Institute will offer a limited number of scholarships to students with active "Institute resident" status:
 - <u>For continuing M.Sc. students</u>: 70% living expenses stipend for students in their second year at the Institute and who have received a scholarship from the Institute please fill out <u>the form</u> by 1.9.25.
 - <u>For new M.Sc. students</u>: the Institute will be able to offer a limited number of scholarships in a competitive process. Please note, an application can be submitted before confirmation of receiving resident status please fill out the form by 1.9.25
 - For PhD students: no living expenses stipend will be offered.
